To address our unprecedented global and immediate need for access to reading and research materials, as of today, March 24, 2020, the Internet Archive will suspend waitlists for the 1.4 million (and growing) books in our lending library by creating a [National Emergency Library](#) to serve the nation's displaced learners. This suspension will run through June 30, 2020, or the end of the US national emergency, whichever is later.

During the waitlist suspension, users will be able to borrow books from the [National Emergency Library](#) without joining a waitlist, ensuring that students will have access to assigned readings and library materials that the Internet Archive has digitized for the remainder of the US academic calendar, and that people who cannot physically access their local libraries because of closure or self-

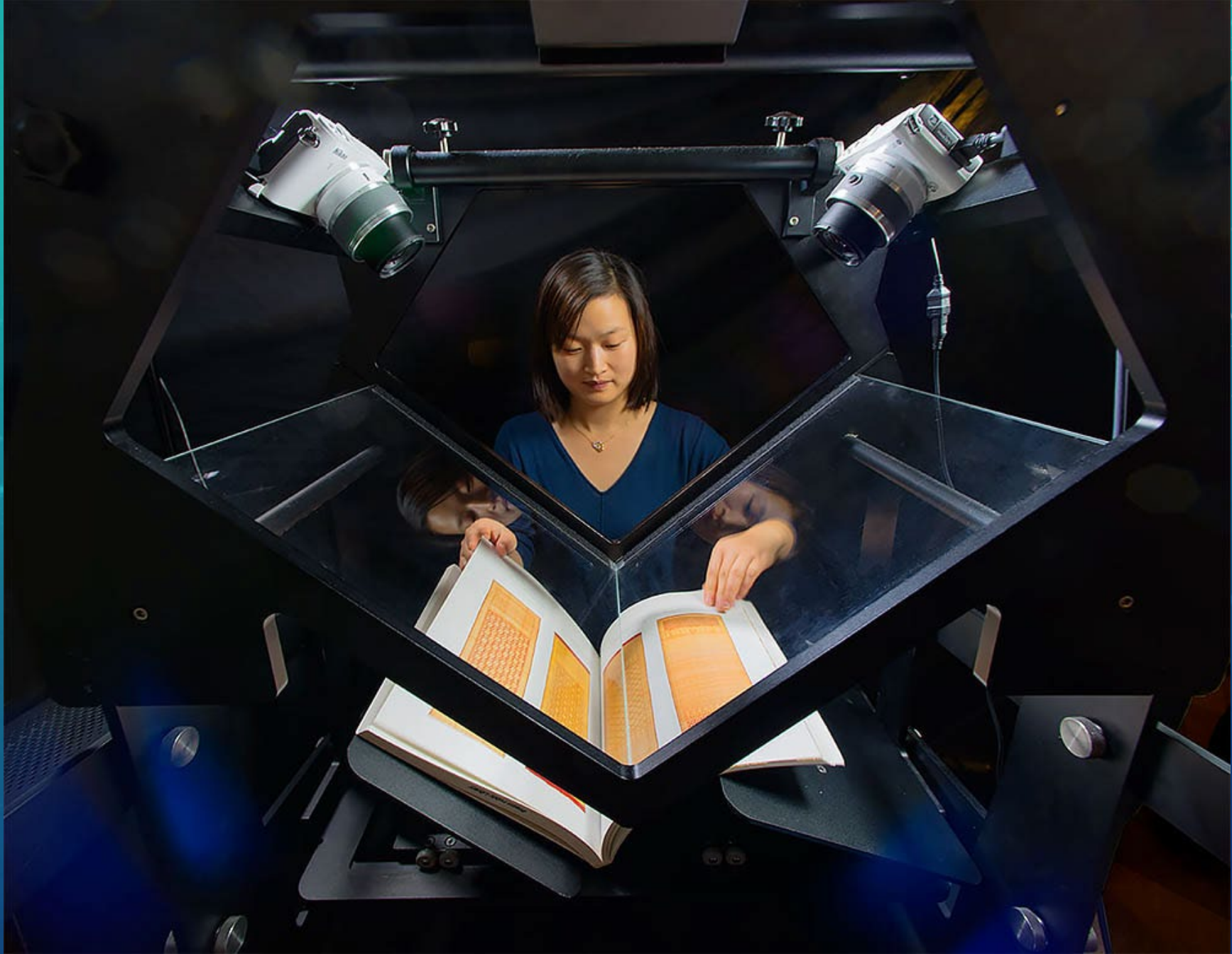

Premier Religious School Donates Quarter of a Million Volumes to Internet Archive's Open Library

Scholars will soon have online access to 250,000 research volumes from a premier theological school, thanks to a [donation](#) from the Claremont School of Theology to the Internet Archive.

Strengths of the collection include Comparative Theology and Philosophy, Feminist Theology, and Afro-Caribbean spirituality. In addition to the 250,000 volumes, the library is donating its Ancient Biblical Manuscripts Collection, the world's largest collection of images of ancient religious (Jewish and Christian, biblical and extra-biblical) manuscripts, currently housed on microfilm. Half to three quarters of the collection contains images of manuscripts which are not currently available on the web from any provider.

The donation stems from a 2019 decision by Claremont, an independent theological school in Southern California, to affiliate with Willamette University in Salem, Oregon.

Claremont students began making the transition to studying in Oregon in the fall of 2019.

The cross-state move also required relocating the institution's Religious Studies research collection. Unfortunately, a large percentage of religious studies materials only exist in print and many tomes are out of print.

The institution's board worried about cutting scholars off during the move. Physical materials can be lent between research institutions via interlibrary loan, but that leaves unaffiliated researchers without access. And public health concerns during the COVID-19 crisis have given these arrangements an uncertain future.

So the Board of Trustees authorized a donation to the Internet Archive so the 250,000 piece collection could be placed in the Internet Archive's Open Library for controlled digital lending, and the Ancient Biblical Manuscripts Collection can be mobilized and made available online. The Internet

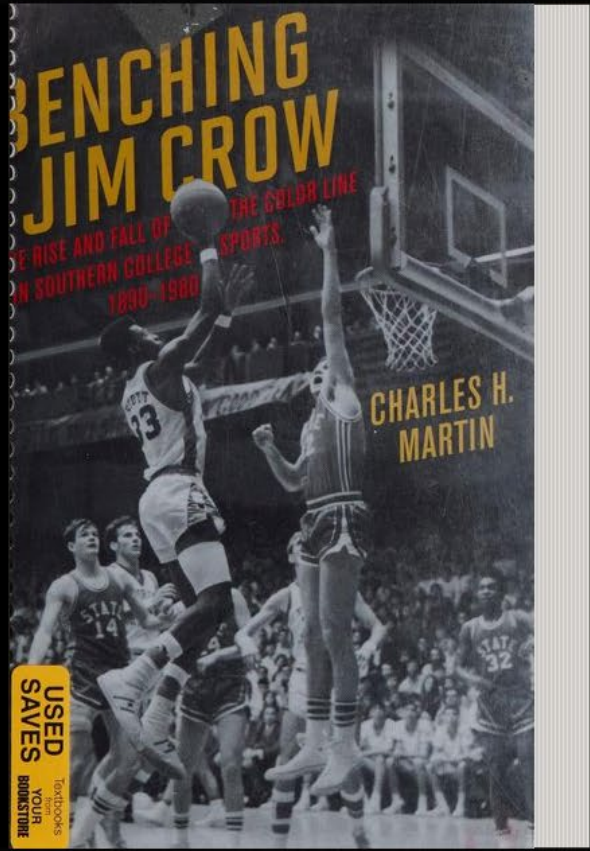

CONTROLLED DIGITAL LENDING

WHAT IS CDL?

Controlled Digital Lending (CDL) is a method by which a library may digitize a print book and lend the digital copy to a patron in a manner consistent with Fair Use and the First Sale doctrine of Copyright law. Through CDL, the library uses technological controls to limit the distribution of the digital copy and maintains an “owned-to-loaned” ratio such that the number of copies of a title loaned out to patrons in any format never exceeds the number of print copies of the title owned by the library.

THE 6 CDL REQUIREMENTS

1. original works are acquired lawfully
2. works are owned and not licensed
3. limit the total number of copies in any format in circulation at any time to the number of physical copies the library lawfully owns (maintain an "owned to loaned" ratio)
4. lend each digital version only to a single user at a time just as a physical copy would be loaned
5. limit the time period for each lend to one that is analogous to physical lending
6. use digital rights management to prevent copying and redistribution

OPEN LIBRARIES

Libraries can partner with the Internet Archive to provide online access to books any of three ways:

1. Identify overlap between print holdings and the Internet Archive's digital holdings. Load records for those books into the library catalog that provide links to the Internet Archive's digital version.
2. Remove selected print titles from circulation and allow the Internet Archive to increment the number of available digital copies.
3. Deaccession and donate books to be digitized (either paying to have them scanned immediately or putting them in the queue to be scanned as funding allows).

OUR GOALS

- Expand e-book access for our online students
- Reduce need for our own (labor-intensive) controlled digital lending offering
- Make the Internet Archive digital holdings more discoverable by our community

OVERLAP ANALYSIS

- Filled out the form to join Open Libraries at openlibraries.org
- Reviewed the provided technical requirements for sending our holdings
- Generated a review file of print book records with ISBNs (which was to be the match point)
- Exported MARC binary file and sent to our Internet Archive contact

RECORD LOAD

- Received back the overlap report, which included the Internet Archive record identifiers
- Extracted the record identifiers and transformed them into URLs for the associated MARCXML records
- Batch downloaded the MARC XML records
- Clean up in MarcEdit
- MCO loaded MARC records into catalog

BATCH DOWNLOADING MARC FILES

- Used the wget command line program on macOS
- `> wget -a archive.log -i archive.org.txt -w 1 --random-wait -nc`
 - `-a archive.log` = log file
 - `-i archive.org.txt` = list of URLs to download
 - `-w 1` = wait 1 second between downloads
 - `--random-wait` = randomize wait time
 - `--nc` = (no clobber) don't redownload duplicates

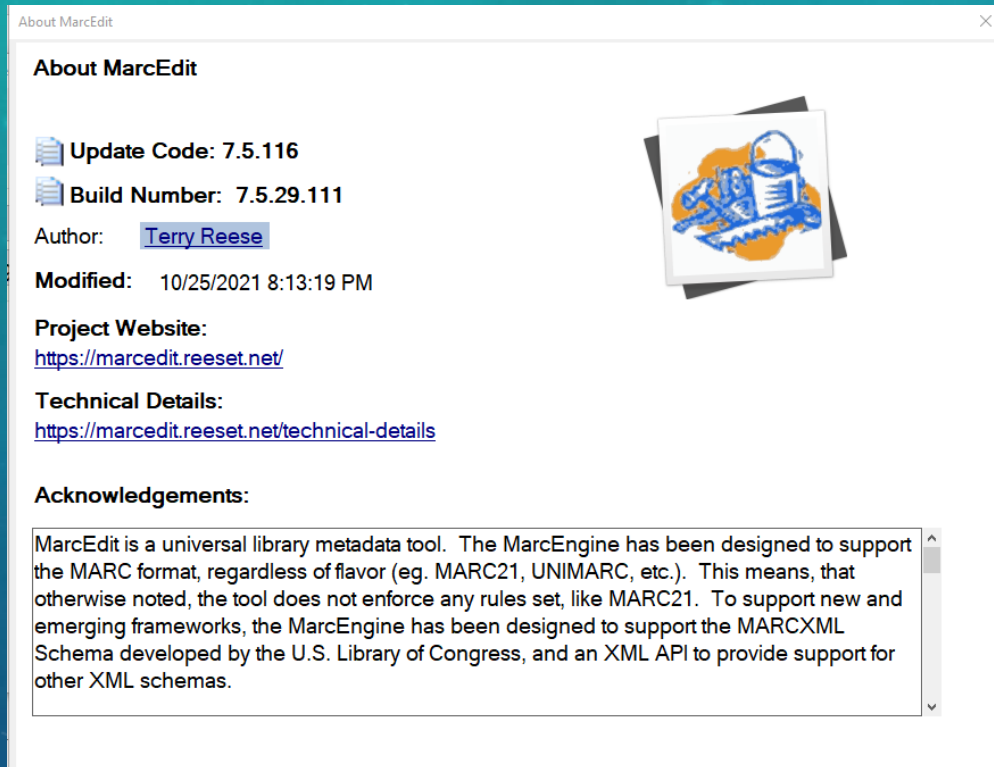
